

## Job Description Electrician Technician

### **\*\* OVERVIEW OF ASSIGNMENT \*\***

The Technician will perform electronic device upgrades under the direction of A Field Service Engineers at various customer hospital facilities.

### **\*\* JOB DUTIES \*\***

The Electronics Technician will work under direction of an on-site Field Service Engineer, and will receive Company training on how to perform the assigned tasks including procedures for basic pump device self-test, Performance Verification Testing, and use of basic related test equipment such as an electrical safety meter.

Technicians must be capable of:

- using standard hand tools to open electronic devices
- removing and replacing circuit boards
- using industry standard Electro-Static Discharge protection equipment and procedures (ESD)
- performing device self-tests in compliance with Company provided procedures
- providing clear hand-written records of device upgrade information on provided documents

### **\*\* SKILLS & REQUIREMENTS \*\***

-Technician must be competent and capable of fulfilling the job duties with excellence while working on-site in a field team environment.

-Position requires two or more years' of recent electronics experience as a field level, or manufacturing technician.

-Previous experience with exposure to upgrading, fixing or installing hospital based biomedical instrumentation preferred but not required

-Must be able to lift and move devices weighing up to 27 lbs. within short distances in the work area, and be able to bend and stoop as needed.
