

With a population of more than 47,000, Monroe, Louisiana is the eighth largest city in the state. Along with its sister city, West Monroe, located across the Ouachita River, Monroe is a regional commercial hub for the 15 parishes that comprise Northeast Louisiana. Encompassing 31.6 square miles, the city is the principal city in the Monroe metropolitan statistical area, the second-largest metropolitan area in North Louisiana. It is also home to the University of Louisiana Monroe.

The Engineering Department is composed of three divisions: Civil Engineering, Traffic Engineering, and Project Management/CIP – Capital Infrastructure. The Department is responsible for planning, reviewing plans and specifications, and coordinating construction for all major infrastructure projects, developing standard practices for public works improvement development, reviewing proposed development projects, maintaining City records for general public works construction, and administering approved policies. It also serves as the overall coordinator for the review and inspection of public works projects in the City's rights-of-way. The City of Monroe seeks a highly responsible person to serve as its new City Engineer to coordinate all City engineering activities. This position is responsible for performing administrative duties associated with budget; overseeing employee administration and routine administrative programs; and planning, developing, and directing major programs and projects.

The selected candidate must hold a bachelor's degree in civil engineering or a relevant engineering discipline and at least three years of supervisory experience. An equivalent combination of education, training, and/or experience will be considered. Candidates must possess a Professional Engineering (P.E.) and Land Surveyor's License (or the ability to obtain within 36 months) as issued by the State of Louisiana Board of Professional Engineers and a valid Louisiana driver's license with a satisfactory driving record. Employment is contingent upon a criminal background check upon hire.

The City of Monroe offers a competitive salary range of \$94,000-\$120,000 depending on qualifications and experience and provides a generous benefits package including health, dental, life insurance, and paid vacation and sick leave.
