

Louisiana Division Area (Civil) Engineer Positions are Open!

The Louisiana Division has two great career opportunities for an Area Engineer GS-0810-11/12. Both positions serve on the Engineering Team and are responsible for providing advice and guidance on Federal laws, regulations, and FHWA policies applicable to Federal-aid projects within the State DOT project development process, in meetings, telephone contacts, public hearings, field reviews, and visits with State DOT officials and other Federal, State, and local agencies for assigned program areas and in assisting in the implementation of leadership initiatives. The incumbents are also responsible for participating in assessing State programs for effectiveness and compliance.

The **ideal candidate** is an engineer with experience monitoring Federally funded highway programs or delivering highway projects from initial scoping through construction support and maintenance; and experience conveying ideas and concepts to persuade others in meetings, discussions, and in writing.

Resumes are being considered at this time. Your resume must contain sufficiently detailed information for us to make a qualification determination. Ensure that your resume contains specific information such as position titles plus work descriptions and accomplishments, beginning and ending dates of employment for each position, average number of hours worked per week, and if the position is/was in the Federal government, you should provide the position series and grade level. Also include phone and email contacts for current professional references. Your resume should demonstrate how you can effectively represent the agency to federal, state and local officials and the general public, and effectively communicate, explain, and apply transportation program requirements.

The announcement closes on **Wednesday February 14, 2024**, and is open to both U.S. Citizens and Federal Employees.
